County of Santa Fe Purchase Order for Services — General Terms and Conditions

Interpretation: The contract between the parties consists of any written agreement between the parties and this Purchase Order. In the event of a conflict between these documents, the terms and conditions of the written agreement shall govern.

Assignment: The Contractor shall not assign or transfer any interest in this Order or assign any claims for money due or to become due under this Order without the advance written approval of the County.

Subcontracting: The Contractor shall not subcontract or delegate any portion of the services to be performed under this Order without the advance written approval of the County.

Modification: No modification to this Order shall be effective unless agreed to in writing by authorized representatives of the County. County employees have no authority to direct any change except by a written change order signed by the County's authorized representative.

Audit: The County may, subject to written notification to the Contractor, inspect the Contractor's facilities. The Contractor shall, without charge, provide facilities for the County's personnel and provide all requested data necessary for the County's adequate inspection.

Governing Law: This Order shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Mexico without regard to its choice of law rules.

Notice of Penalties: The Procurement Code, NMSA 1978, Sections 13-1-28 through 13-1-199, imposes civil and criminal penalties for its violation. In addition, New Mexico criminal statutes impose penalties for bribes, gratuities, and kickbacks.

Waiver: The failure of the County to insist in any one or more instances, upon the performance of any of the terms or conditions of this Order or to exercise any right hereunder shall not be construed as a waiver or relinquishment of the future performance of any such term or condition or the future exercise of such right. The obligation of the Contractor with respect to such future performance shall continue in full force and effect.

Delivery: Time is of the essence in this Purchase Order and, if performance of conforming services is not completed by the time(s) promised, the County reserves the right, in addition to its other rights and remedies, to cancel this Order, to reject such services in whole or in part, or to purchase substitute services elsewhere and charge the Contractor with any loss incurred. Any provisions herein for performance of services by installments shall not be construed as making the obligations of the Contractor severable.

Payment: The Contractor shall submit a written request for payment to the County. Within 15 days of the County's receipt of the invoice, the County shall issue a written certification of complete or partial acceptance or rejection of the contractual items or services for which payment is sought. Within 30 days of the issuance of a written certification accepting the contractual items or services, the County shall tender payment for the accepted items or services. In the event the County fails to tender payment within 30 days of the written certification accepting the items or services, the County shall pay late payment charges of one and one-half percent per month until the amount due is paid in full.

Indemnification: The Contractor shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the County and its Elected Officials, agents and employees, from and against any losses, liabilities, damages, demands, suits, causes of action, judgments, costs or expenses resulting from or directly or indirectly arising out of the Contractor's performance or non-performance of its obligations under this Order, including but not limited to the Contractor's breach of any representation or warranty made herein.

Insurance: The Contractor shall procure and maintain during the life of this Order a comprehensive general liability and automobile insurance policy with liability limits in amounts not less than \$1,050,000 combined single limits, for bodily injury, including death, and property damage for any one occurrence. Said policy of insurance shall include coverage for all operations performed by the Contractor; coverage for the use of all owned, non-owned hired automobiles, vehicles and other equipment, both on and off work; and contractual liability coverage under which this Order is an insured contract. If during the life of this Order, the Legislature of the State of New Mexico increases the maximum limits of liability under the New Mexico Tort Claims Act, the Contractor shall increase the maximum limits of any insurance required herein.

Permits, Fees, and Licenses: The Contractor shall procure all permits and licenses, pay all charges, fees, and royalties, and give all notices necessary and incidental to the due and lawful performance of its obligations hereunder.

Termination: The County reserves the right to terminate this Order at any time with respect to any undelivered services by written notification of oral notice confirmed in writing.

SCOPE OF WORK AND PROJECT SCHEDULE**

A. SCOPE OF WORK

The contractor shall provide all labor, equipment, materials and services necessary to complete the following services.

Provide Traffic Control (Stamped by Engineer), Mobilization, Clearing and Grubbing (widening of the road and shaping will need to be included as an incidental), Removal of Structures and Obstructions (will need to include the removal and installation of mailboxes), Subgrade Preparation, Base Course, Hot Mix Asphalt (SP-IV) and install 1380 ft. of 21" x 15" Arch culvert pipe and 230 ft. of 28" x 20" Arch culvert pipe in accordance with Santa Fe County and NMDOT specifications. Subgrade preparation shall be placed on a 2% crown and will be 22' wide, it will need to be prepared in accordance with the attached specifications and all bar ditches will be cleared and shaped. Base course shall be placed at a final depth of 4" and the HMA will consist of one 2" lift compacted in accordance with specifications. Culverts will be installed along marked areas and will need to be compacted in accordance to specifications.

In accordance with NMSA 1978 13-1-154.1 B. A state agency may procure multiple indefinite quantity construction contracts pursuant to a price agreement for multiple projects under a single request for proposals, provided the total amount of a contract and all renewals does not exceed two million dollars (\$2,000,000.00) over four years and the contract provides that any one purchase order under the contract may not exceed five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00).

The Purchasing Division issued a two-step Request for Proposal (RFP) for On-Call Road Maintenance & Construction Materials. Effectively immediately the following vendors will be used by Santa Fe County for Road Maintenance & Construction Materials.

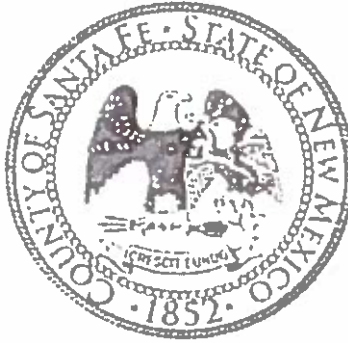

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into on this 26th day of January 2018, by and between SANTA FE COUNTY (hereinafter referred to as the "(County)"), a New Mexico political subdivision, and GM EMULSION, LLC, a company licensed to do business in the State of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor".

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the County needs road construction and maintenance services on an "on-call" basis and as-needed for a variety of projects throughout the County as funding becomes available and as specific needs are identified; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 13-1-112 NMSA 1978, competitive sealed proposals were solicited through Request for Proposal (RFP) No. 2018-0071-PW/MM for these services; and

WHEREAS, the County selected multiple qualified and experienced contractors to assist the County in a variety of road construction projects pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 13-1-154.; and

WHEREAS, based upon the evaluation criteria stated in the RFP for the purpose of determining the most qualified offerors, the County has determined the Contractor as one of the most responsive and highest rated offerors; and

WHEREAS, the County requires the services of the Contractor and the Contractor is willing to provide these services and both parties wish to enter into this Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and mutual obligations herein in Parts A and B of this Agreement, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. PURPOSE OF THIS ON-CALL AGREEMENT

The purpose of this Agreement for road construction and maintenance services on an "on-call" basis is to provide for the timely availability of road construction services for projects as needed by the County. During the term of this on-call Agreement, the County in its sole discretion will determine the projects to be assigned to the Contractor. When assigning a project to the Contractor, the County will issue a Project Assignment using the Attachment 1 form attached hereto. The assignment will include a description of the assigned scope of work or services, a project schedule and the Contractor's costs and compensation for completion of the assigned project. If the Contractor plans to use consultants or subcontractors for a particular project assignment the Contractor will also provide a completed Sub Contractor's form indicated on Exhibit F, attached hereto. For each project assignment the County will send the Contractor a notice to proceed with the assignment using the Authorization to Proceed form (Exhibit K and Attachment 2).

2. SCOPE OF WORK

A. The scope of work as determined by the County will be described on Attachment 1 at the time a Project Assignment is made to the Contractor.

3. COMPENSATION, INVOICING, AND SET-OFF

A. In consideration of its obligations under this Agreement the Contractor shall be compensated as follows:

- 1) Contractor acknowledges and agrees that this Agreement executed by the parties does not authorize the performance of any services or work, commit funds to compensate Contractor for any services or work performed, or obligate the County to compensate the Contractor for any services or work. Services or work shall be authorized by issuance of a Project Assignment (Attachment 1) together with a purchase order issued by the County to the Contractor after execution of this Agreement, which purchase order shall set forth the matter for which services or work is authorized and the maximum compensation available for the authorized services or work. The total maximum compensation available to Contractor under this Agreement and all Project Assignments issued under this Agreement shall not exceed \$2,000,000.00, exclusive of NM grt, over the term of this Agreement and/or any one purchase order issued under this Agreement shall not exceed \$500,000, exclusive of NM grt.
- 2) For all purchase orders issued under this Agreement, the County shall compensate the Contractor for services satisfactorily performed. All costs and expenses shall be in accordance with Exhibit A (Bid Sheets) and as stated in the Project Assignment (Attachment 1, Project Assignment form).
- 3) The total amount payable to the Contractor under this Agreement, exclusive of NM grt shall not exceed \$2,000,000.00 over the term of this Agreement. Any NM grt levied on the amounts payable under this Agreement shall be paid by the County to the Contractor.
- 4) This amount is a maximum and not a guarantee that the work assigned to be performed by Contractor under this Agreement shall equal the amount stated herein. The parties do not intend for the Contractor to continue to provide services without compensation when the total compensation amount is reached. The County will notify the Contractor when the services provided under this Agreement reach the total compensation amount. In no event will the Contractor be paid for services provided in excess of the total compensation amount without this Agreement being amended.

B. The Contractor shall submit a written request for payment, on the form attached hereto as Exhibit B (Pay Request form), when payment is due under this Agreement. Upon the County's receipt of the written request, the County shall issue a written certification of complete or partial acceptance or rejection of the

contractual items or services for which payment is sought. The Contractor acknowledges and agrees that the County may not make any payment hereunder unless and until the County has issued a written certification accepting the contractual items or services. Within 30 days of the issuance of a written certification accepting the contractual items or services, the County shall tender payment for the accepted items or services. In the event the County fails to tender payment within 30 days of the written certification accepting the items or services, the County shall pay late payment charges of one and one-half percent (1.5%) per month, until the amount due is paid in full.

- C. In the event the Contractor breaches this Agreement, the County may, without penalty, withhold any payments due the Contractor for the purpose of set-off until such time as the County determines the exact amount of damages it suffered as a result of the breach.
- D. Payment under the Agreement shall not foreclose the right of the County to recover excessive or illegal payment.

3. If we need to remove driveway culverts decorative rocks, will we need to replace?
The contractors will need to replace decorative rocks or structures as needed.
4. Where will the staging area be for this project?

Traffic Control Specification
January 26, 2018**

**Description**

The work consists of providing a traffic control plan and traffic control management including supervision of personal and the installation, inspection, and maintenance of traffic control devices. The Contractor shall furnish all labor, equipment, and traffic control devices necessary to provide a safe work zone. All required signing and traffic control devices shall be in compliance with the current edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

Management of the traffic control shall be performed in accordance with section 618 Traffic Control Management of the Standard Specifications for Highway and Bridge Construction New Mexico State Department of Transportation 2014 edition.

Traffic Control Plan

The Traffic Control Plan shall be submitted on 11" x 17" paper and shall be stamped by a registered professional engineer in the State of New Mexico. The traffic control plan shall be created using a CADD program and submitted to the Santa Fe County Project Manager for approval.

Pavement Drop-Offs

Pavement drop-offs occur when the longitudinal edge of the travel lane is not flush with the adjacent existing surface.

Case 1 - Activities within the Travel Lane Such as Milling or Overlay Operations

A maximum 1 ½" vertical drop-off between adjacent surfaces will be allowed at the centerline of lanes without treatment. When the drop-off is greater than 1 ½" a fillet with a slope of 3:1 or flatter shall be provided during non-working hours. The work shall be scheduled to result in not more than one day operation of exposed longitudinal joint between adjacent surfaces.

Case 2 - Areas Adjacent to the Existing Travel Lane with Buffer Zones Less than 6ft in Width

A buffer zone is defined as any smooth, transversable surface that does not contain any obstruction or drop offs.

- A. A slope of 3:1 or flatter should be constructed whenever possible.
- B. Drop offs greater than 1 ½" that are exposed to traffic during non-working hours shall be protected by a fillet (3:1 or flatter) or delineation by drums, vertical panels or other delineation devices.

- C. For drop-offs greater than 1 foot, if a fillet of less than 3:1 slope is not achievable, positive barrier (concrete wall barrier or approved equal) should be used.

Case 3-Areas Adjacent to the Existing Travel Lane with Buffer Zones 6ft or more in Width

- A. A slope of 3:1 or flatter should be constructed whenever possible.
- B. For drop-offs less than 2 feet, vertical panels or other delineation devices shall be used.
- C. For drop-offs greater than 2 feet, if a fillet of less than 3:1 slope is not achievable, positive barrier (concrete wall barrier or approved equal) should be used.

Case 4 – Point Drop-offs Such as Drop Inlets and CBC Ends.

When this type of drop-off is present, every effort should be made to place the appropriate permanent nature, such as guardrail or inlet grates, as soon as possible.

- 1. For drop-offs located 6ft. or more from the travel lane, Type "B" drums shall be used to delineate the hazard.
- 2. For drop-offs located less than 6ft. from the travel lane, positive barrier (concrete wall barrier or approved equal) protection shall be provided. Type "B" drums may be used if the drop-off will be exposed for less than 24 hours.

Work Included in Payment

All labor, materials and equipment to provide traffic control for the construction project. Payment shall be full compensation for the traffic control devices, traffic control plan and the daily management of the traffic control and no further payment will be made.

Construction Requirements

Maximum dry density of all soil types encountered or used will be determined in accordance with AASHTO T 180 (Modified Proctor) Method D (TCCP Modified) and AASHTO T 224.

Compact the top six inches of the Roadbed to 95% of maximum density.

Ensure the soil moisture content (at the time of compaction) is from optimum minus five percent (5%). For soils with a PI of 15 or greater, ensure the moisture content of the soil at the time of compaction is from optimum moisture to optimum moisture plus four percent (4%).

Conduct field density tests at locations according to Minimum Testing Requirements, in accordance with AASHTO T 130.

Tolerances

Ensure the top surface of the finished Subgrade is either crowned at 2% or super-elevated at 2% to that assure water drains into the ditches. Adjusting the profile of the subgrade should be limited to minor adjustments and must be approved by the Project Manager.

Cleaning and re-shaping of the roadside ditches to assure drainage leaves the roadway and enters the drainage structures will be incidental to this pay item and no additional payment will be included. Subgrade Preparation will be paid for at a width of 22' for the length of the subgrade. No payment will be made for re-handling or reworking material to meet moisture and density requirements.

Description

The Aggregate Index (AI) combines test values from the Los Angeles Wear Test, Soundness Loss Test, and Absorption Test. The AI is a single value representing the overall quality of the source from which the aggregates are obtained. Do not use to evaluate individual aggregate stockpile quality.

Sampling and Testing Procedures

Determine Los Angeles wear, soundness loss, and absorption values for the AI equation using at least five random test samples obtained from all stockpiles at the source in accordance with AASHTO T 2. Submit all of the five samples to a Department approved private Laboratory for combination into a single sample. The Project Manager or the State Materials Bureau will have a list of approved private laboratories. Extract a representative test sample from the single sample to determine the Los Angeles wear and absorption values.

Prepare the sample used to determine the absorption as follows:

Plus 3/4 in	1000 grams
3/4 in to 1/2 in	1000 grams
1/2 in to 3/8 in	1000 grams
3/8 in to #4	1000 grams

Separate the remaining amount of the single sample into five test samples using the procedures in AASHTO T 248. Calculate a soundness loss value for each of these five samples using Table 910.2:1, "Standard Gradation for Soundness Loss Testing."

Average the five soundness loss results to obtain the overall soundness loss value for the subject aggregate pit.

Testing of Aggregates

Perform the following tests using a State Materials Bureau approved Testing Laboratory:

1. Los Angeles Wear (in accordance with AASHTO T 96, Method B);
2. Soundness loss (in accordance with AASHTO T 104); and
3. Absorption (in accordance with AASHTO T 85 or NMDOT 001 (20066)).

Use the same private Laboratory for the entire project unless otherwise approved (in writing) by the Project Manager.

Obtain samples under the observation of the Project Manager.

Split samples into two samples in accordance with AASHTO T 248.

Frequency of Testing

Submit samples at least once every year to maintain continuous approval of Commercial Material Sources.

Equation

Calculate the AI of a coarse aggregate to the nearest whole number in accordance with the following equation:

$$AI = \frac{1}{3} \sqrt{LA^{2.2} + SL^{3.0} + A^{4.0}}$$

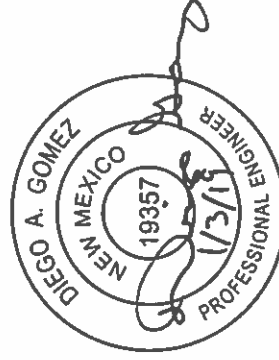
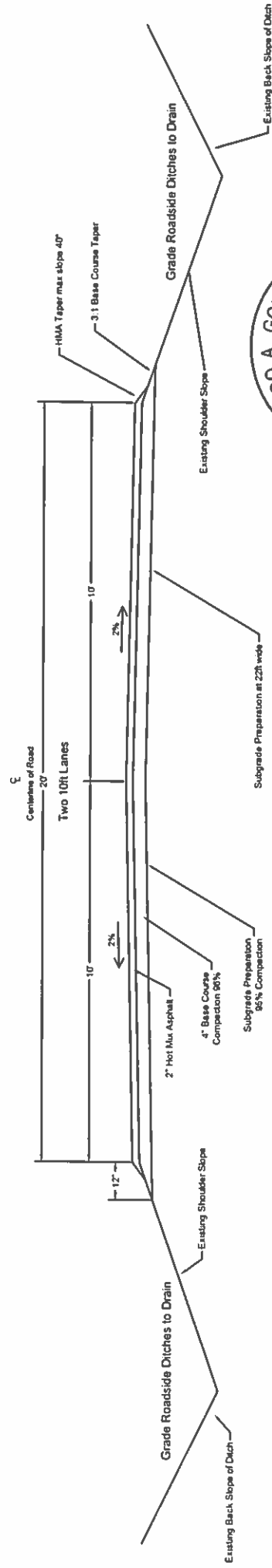
where:

| LA | is the Los Angeles Wear, the percent of aggregate wear at 500 revolutions if tested in accordance with AASHTO T 96 |
| SL | is the soundness loss of the sample if tested in accordance with AASHTO T 104 using magnesium sulfate with a test duration of 5 cycles and a standard gradation |
| A | is the absorption, the amount of moisture retained if tested in accordance with AASHTO T 85 |

Example:

1. Determine the L.A. Wear as a whole number – for example, 25;
2. Determine the Soundness Loss as a whole number – for example, 15;
3. Determine the Absorption as a whole number – for example, 3;
4. Calculate the value of the L.A. Wear taken to the 2.2 power –
that is, $25^{2.2} = 1189.8$;
5. Calculate the value of the Soundness Loss taken to the 3rd power –
that is, $15^3 = 3375$;
6. Calculate the value of the Absorption taken to the 4th power –
that is, $3^4 = 81.0$;
7. Add the value obtained from steps 4, 5, and 6 –
that is, $1189.8 + 3375 + 81.0 = 4645.8$;
8. Determine the square root of Step 7 – that is, $\sqrt{4645.8} = 68.2$;
9. Divide the result from Step 8 by 3 – that is, $68.2 \div 3 = 22.7$; The A.I. for this sample is 22.7.

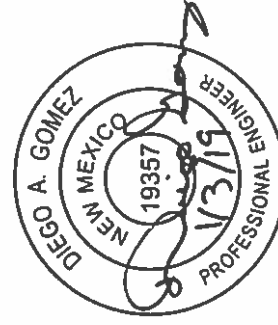
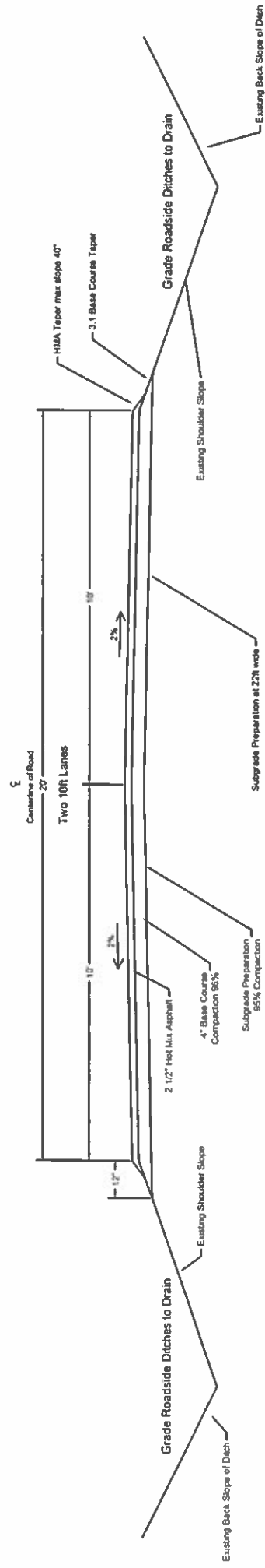
