Dear Mr. Sandoval,

I am writing to request an extension of Co-op Agreement CNS100120.

We are currently in completing Phase C of the Alignment Study but must provide an additional amendment to the agreement to provide the remaining Environmental Survey for the preferred alignment of the SE Connector and any remaining Phase C work on the NE Connector. Santa Fe County will not be ready to close out this work by the current deadline of September 30th, 2016. Given a timely approval of the amendment to the Consultant's contract, we expect to be requesting reimbursement for the completion of the Corridor and Alignment Study by the end of January 2017.

The justification for this request is as follows:

- Santa Fe County and NMDOT have been working together to plan and implement the construction of two transportation facilities, the NE Connector and the SE Connector.
- In February of 2016 NMDOT D5 and Santa Fe County worked together to coordinate the execution of requirements for issuing RFPs to design and build the NE and SE Connectors.
- The 2nd Amendment to the MOU, changed the responsibility for the design and construction of the Northeast connector from SFC to the NMDOT, with SFC responsible for the environmental clearance and ROW acquisition only.
- SFC remained responsible for the design and construction of the SE Connector.
- The Phase C of CNS100120 includes the environmental clearances for the NE Connector alignment.
- NMDOT delayed the release of the RFP for Engineering Design to establish the alignment for the NE Connector and thereby limiting SFC ability to complete the Phase C and invoice for this work by September 30, 2016.
- SFC has adjusted their agreement with the design team for the Alignment Study to increase the study area for the environmental clearance in order to provide clearance for any likely alignment of the NE and SE Connector in order to complete the required studies and close out the contract.

Please prepare and send an amendment to the grant to extend the term of the project until March 30, 2017.

RECITALS

Whereas, the Department and the County entered into a Cooperative Project Agreement on March 9, 2012, attached as Exhibit "A" and made part of this Amendment; and,

Whereas, page 11, Section 22, of the Agreement allows both parties to make alterations and revisions to the said Agreement; and,

Whereas, the County is requesting a six month extension on the Agreement termination date; and,

Whereas, it has become necessary to amend the Agreement to change the termination date and extend the termination date from September 30,2016 to March 31, 2017; and,

Whereas, the Department and the County agree that the original Cooperative Agreement be amended.

In consideration of the covenants contained herein and pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 67-3-28, and the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Page 10, Section 20, Paragraph 1, delete in its entirety and insert the following:
 - 1. This Agreement shall terminate on **March 31, 2017**. Neither Party shall have any obligation after said date except as stated in Section Seven.

Except for the above amendments the original Cooperative Project Agreement shall remain in full force and effect unless expressly amended or modified by this Second Amendment.
