

AMENDMENT NO. 2  
TO THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN THE  
NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (DoIT)  
AND  
SANTA FE COUNTY FOR EQUIPMENT  
HOSTING

THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into by and between New Mexico Department of Information Technology ("DoIT") and Santa Fe County ("County"). On May 2, 2016, DoIT and the County entered into Memorandum of Agreement No. 2016-0237-IT/BT ("MOA") to provide for equipment hosting in DoIT's John Simms Data Center in Santa Fe, NM.

According to Article 7 of the MOA, the MOA may be amended by an instrument in writing executed by the parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES AGREE TO AMEND THE MOA AS FOLLOWS:


1. Article 2 paragraph A and the services table are deleted in their entirety and replaced with the following:
  - A. The compensation to be paid by the County to DoIT for equipment hosting will be based on DoIT's published rates which are available online at <http://www.doit.state.nm.us/services.html> and which are subject to change dependent on annual Rate Committee approval.
2. Article 3 is amended with the following:
3. **TERM**

This Agreement will become effective upon the date of the last signature by the Parties (Effective Date) and will terminate on May 2, 2018 unless earlier terminated pursuant to Sections 4 or 9 of this Agreement. The County has the option to extend the Term of this Agreement in one-year increments by providing 30 days written notice to the DoIT.

**All other articles of the original Agreement and Amendment No. 1 to the original Agreement remain the same.**


