Response

PR002 - Deduct on Red/Green Lights - This proposal request pricing is fair and reasonable for the owner deletion of a part of the scope. No days are associated with this change order.

COR003 - Control Joints - This proposal request pricing is fair and reasonable for the contractor's misreading of the plans (control joints are shown on architectural but not structural) and addition of some joints. No days are associated with this change order.

PR004a/COR006 - Ground-Mount Unit - This proposal request pricing was accepted by Santa Fe County for the relocation of the mechanical unit required because the existing structure was found to be insufficient to support the unit (this was not discovered until the ceiling was opened). The days associated with this change order are during the same period as the septic system days below, therefore no days are associated with this change order.

PR005 - Deletion of Septic System - This proposal request pricing is fair and reasonable for the credit on the septic system (This was an alternate that the owner decided to eliminate from the project late in construction; the alternate price of \$6500 is credited). There are 20 days associated with this change order; see attached timeline of additional days.

Tile - There is no cost associated with this change order; the fire department took 7 days to reach a decision on the tile pattern.

Fire Alarm - There is not cost associated with this change order; the county delayed the project because it needed make arrangements to install the fire alarm devices (a separate project).

ADDITIONAL DAYS

Water Line/Septic

The water line/septic system issue began on 9/4/14 rather than 9/8/14. We were told in an email 9/11/14 that if we did not receive a response by 9/12/14 at noon we would be officially delayed. We were told in a separate email on 9/14/14 that this item affected the schedule of parking lot striping, installation of septic and oil/sand separation and plumbing final. The decision to eliminate the septic system was made 9/24/14.

Mechanical Unit

Issues with placing the mechanical unit on the roof began on 8/16/14 when the actual roof assembly was uncovered by the Contractor and it was sent to my engineer who found that the roof could not support the load of the unit (and was not to code). The rfi was answered on 8/19/14, and a change order request was issued by the Contractor on 8/25/14. Comments on pricing were returned the same day. It was decided in the next progress meeting to ask for a price to ground-mount the unit. Pricing was received on 9/3/14. Ron and I spoke and decided to proceed with a change directive in the absence of agreement on price. We were told in an emails on 9/9/14 and 9/11/14 that if we did not receive a response by 9/12/14 at noon we would be officially delayed. The change directive was prepared on 9/3/14 and was signed by the County on 9/12/14.

Tile

Initial question sent 10/8/14 (a Wednesday); final decision by Fire Dept. not 10/15. Per Anissa's 10/19/14 email, the tile installers were pulled off the job and needed to be remobilized. She said she would know when they'd be back on the job on 10/20/14. Response time for the initial question was 7 days which is within standard response times. 7 days (10/8/14 to 10/15/14)

Fire Alarm

During my telephone conversation with Anissa on 11/4/14, she indicated that they still had two days to finish up to call for inspection. On 11/13 she said that they had slowed down knowing that they would not get a co without the fire alarm; I do not have the date when Anissa first brought this up to me, but I notified the Fire Department on 10/28/14, so I think it was on or just before this date. During our 11/4/14 discussion she decided to finish up and call for inspection knowing that the inspector comment would be that fire alarm was not complete. Inspection was called on 11/6/14, that comment was noted, and in my opinion this was the substantial completion date.


