A RESOLUTION TO RECOGNIZE AGUA FRIA VILLAGE ASSOCIATION AS A COMMUNITY ORGANIZATION FOR AGUA FRIA COMMUNITY DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, on October 27, 2015, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the Sustainable Growth Management Plan (SGMP) and designated it as the comprehensive plan for Santa Fe County as prescribed by New Mexico law, including but not limited to NMSA 1978, Section 3-21-5;

WHEREAS, the SGMP provides that the County will establish Community Organizations (CO) "for communities and community-oriented organizations to have an improved public participation process to meet community needs and to make recommendations with respect to development projects and community development issues;"

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2016, the Board of County Commissioners adopted the Sustainable Land Development Code (SLDC), which governs land use and development throughout the unincorporated areas of the County;

WHEREAS, the SLDC establishes the creation of COs and sets out the application and approval process; and

WHEREAS, Agua Fria Village Association has applied to become a CO to represent Agua Fria Community District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Santa Fe County that Agua Fria Village Association is hereby recognized as the CO for Agua Fria Community District.
