End of Early and Absentee Voting Approaching

Geraldine Salazar, Santa Fe County Clerk, wants to remind people that the end of Early Voting and Absentee Voting for the 2018 Primary Election is fast approaching.

Absentee Ballots: You can apply for an absentee ballot now or anytime up until Friday, June 1st, although we encourage voters not to wait until the last minute. By law, the last day we can send out Absentee Ballots is Friday, June 1st. To apply for an Absentee Ballot, you can go online to electronically request an Absentee Ballot Application Request, you may also go to (http://www.santafecountynm.gov/userfiles/ABGeraldine.pdf) to print an application, or call the County Clerk's Office (505-986-6280) to request an application. All Absentee Ballots must be returned by 7:00 PM on Election Night, June 5, 2018. You can hand-deliver Absentee Ballots to the Clerk's Office or to any Voting Convenience Center (VCC) on Election Day.

Early Voting: Early Voting at the Clerk's Office and alternate sites ends Saturday, June 2nd.
