Attached please find the Santa Fe County FY 2012 Final Budget submission for your review and approval. This budget was approved by the Santa Fe County Board of County Commissioners via formal Resolution on June 28, 2011.

Per DFA requirements, below is the requested information as noted in the "Checklist of Budget Documents" for Counties and the Fiscal Year 2011-2012 Budget Preparation Memorandum from John A. Gallegos dated 5/31/11:

- The contract for audit of the financial statements for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2011 has been procured and approved by the Office of the State Auditor. The amount of this contract for to conduct the above audit is \$93,245.00 plus applicable gross receipts tax. Adequate funding has been appropriated for this cost across operating funds. In addition, contingency funding is available should the Auditors' scope of work be expanded.
- The total number of FTEs in the Final Budget is 934.3 with \$42,035,875 budgeted for salaries and wages. The average rate of salary increase is 0% as salary increases were not provided in the FY 2012 budget.
- The Sheriff's Office has not sought to carryover LEPF funding, thus a check in the amount of \$521.03 will be issued to the Department of Finance and Administration returning the excess funding.
- The formally approved FY 2011 fourth quarter financial report (unaudited) has been submitted on the required forms under separate cover and via e-mail.
- The FY 2012 Final Budget request has been submitted on the required forms via e-mail.

Dear Chair Vigil:

The final budget of your local government entity for Fiscal Year 2011-12, as approved by your governing body, has been examined and reviewed. We find it has been developed in accordance with applicable statutes and budgeting guidelines. Sufficient resources appear to be available to cover budgeted expenditures.

In accordance with Section 6-6-2-(E) NMSA 1978, the Local Government Division (Division) certifies your final FY 2011-12 budget. *The Budget Certification Rule*, 2.2.3 NMAC, requires that your most recent audit that should have been submitted to the Office of the State Auditor as of this time is for FY 2009-10. Our information indicates that you are in compliance with this requirement.

Budgets approved by the Division are required to be made a part of the minutes of your governing body according to Section 6-6-5 NMSA 1978. In addition, Section 6-6-6 NMSA 1978 provides that the approved budget will be binding on local officials and governing authorities. Any official or governing authority approving claims or paying warrants in excess of the approved budget or available funds will be liable for such claims and warrants allowed.

Furthermore, state statute requires all revenue sources be expended only for public purposes, and if applicable, in accordance with the Procurement Code, Chapter 13, Article 1, NMSA 1978. Use of public revenue is further governed by Article 9, Section 14 of the Constitution of the State of New Mexico, commonly referred to as the Anti-donation clause.

Finally, please be advised that approval by the Division is required by Section 6-6-2 (G)(H) NMSA 1978, of all transfers between funds and all budget increases.
