DEBT OBLIGATIONS

Debt and Debt Service Per Capita

Santa Fe County (including incorporated areas) has a total outstanding debt per capita of \$1,487.10 (based on 2011 American Community Survey population estimates). This can be broken down into outstanding general obligation debt per capita of \$841.41 and outstanding revenue bond and other debt per capita of \$645.69.

Three general obligation bond questions totalling \$35 million will be taken to the voters at the General Election in November, 2012. If all bond questions are approved, the new general obligation bonds, once issued, will increase the outstanding general obligation debt per capita to \$1,081.72 and the total outstanding debt per capita to \$1,727.41, an increase of \$240.31 per person. The revenue bond debt per capita will not be impacted by the bond questions.

Debt service per capita in fiscal year 2013 totals \$138.33: \$86.88 for general obligation debt service, and \$51.45 for revenue bond and other debt service. Debt service in fiscal year 2013 will be unaffected by the bond elections.
